How is the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child implemented in Switzerland and Liechtenstein?

To find the answer to this question, UNICEF Switzerland and Liechtenstein and OST – Eastern Switzerland University of Applied Sciences have launched the “Child Rights Barometer” for long-term **monitoring** of the implementation of children’s rights.

Because although much is said about children, we still don’t know how they are really doing and what’s needed to support their well-being. At the same time, children are rarely asked about this themselves.

The “**Child Rights Barometer**” is an instrument developed in cooperation with children for the comprehensive and regular assessment of children’s rights in Switzerland and Liechtenstein. The research provides a basis for developing measures to improve the implementation of children’s rights in Switzerland and Liechtenstein.
